

How to get there

Cabbage Tree Bay Aquatic Reserve can be accessed on foot or by vehicle.

There are two land based access points:

- **Bower Street** leads all the way to Shelly Beach Metered Carpark at Shelly Beach Headland.
- **Marine Parade** is a scenic coastal walkway extending the length of the Aquatic Reserve from Manly to Shelly Beach - parking and ramp access into the water is available for the disabled.

Future Planning

NSW Fisheries is assisting Council to implement the Cabbage Tree Bay Management Plan.

This plan was adopted in 2000 by Manly Council to provide for the protection and sustainable use of all resources in the Bay. Future planning for the management of this Aquatic Reserve will involve the local community.



What happens if you break the rules?

Penalties are severe for breaking the rules.

NSW Fisheries legislation provides for:

- fines up to \$110,000.
- the inspection and/or confiscation of fishing gear or diving equipment.
